ABOUT

The Moyie and Area Emergency Response Group was formed in 2009 by a dedicated group of community members with a strong passion to have a safer community.

The group functions as a committee of the Moyie Community Association and the main funding comes from the residents of the Moyie Lake area.

There are four zones for Emergency Response, each with a Captain and Co-Captain and close to forty volunteers.

IN CASE OF EMERGENCY

In case of an emergency, REMAIN CALM and refer to the Emergency Response list which is widely distributed throughout the community or use the following information:

POLICE

Call 911 for an emergency and the RCMP will respond or (250) 489-3471 for a non-emergency.

MEDICAL EMERGENCY

Call 911 to request an ambulance

DEFIBRILLATORS

The defibrillators are located in the Moyie Community Hall and the Janzen home in Moyie Shores. Call a responder on the list above and a defibrillator will be delivered to you. If you need someone to perform CPR, call on of the First Air Persons first.

FIRE

DO NOT call 911 – No one will respond!

Call the Captain or Co-Captain in your area, who will have keys to the Emergency Response Trailer. If neither are available, try the next adjacent area's Captain or Co-Captain. Then contact responders in your own zone who will be able to assist until the trailer arrives.

TO REPORT A FOREST FIRE OR BRUSH FIRE

Call B.C. Forestry at: 1-800-663-5555

Then call your local zone Captain or Co-Captain

If you are located in an area that is difficult to find, especially at night, if someone is available have them meet a member of the response group at a known location (i.e. stop sign, corner junction, etc) and direct them to the emergency. If not, turn on as many house lights as possible.
